

HELPFUL HINTS FOR A SUCCESSFUL CHRISTMAS MARKET

- All work must be accompanied by an inventory sheet listing the items and price. (CVAG will print the price tags). Please put your name and consignor number on sheet.
- Quality, original Christmas decorations, in the \$5 to \$20 range, are very popular.
- Gifts for men - shaving mugs/soap, jewellery, picture frames, coffee mugs.
- Children's gifts – stocking stuffers are always popular.
- Display stands help showcase your work.
- Artist bios, artist cards and product info help sell work.
- Earrings & necklaces are more easily and effectively displayed when on cards or stands.
- Pendants sell more easily if chains are also available, with gift boxes.
- CVAG will not be responsible for damage to items not wrapped or protected, i.e. paper products (cards, prints etc.), fabrics, soaps, etc. We do not pay out for damages to glass and raku.
- We are unable to return unsold work by post or courier following the Craft Fair.
- Allocation of display space at Craft Fair is the decision of the Galley Shop Manager.

Important Dates:

- October 8th Submission applications due
- October 15th Notification given by phone or email
- October 16th to November 1st Initial delivery of work
- November 18th Christmas Craft Fair opens
- December 31st Christmas Craft Fair closes
- January 7th, 2012 Last day to pick up stock

Cheques will be paid mid January for Christmas Sales.

Hours of operations will be in keeping with downtown businesses.

Previous entry to the CVAG Christmas Craft Fair DOES NOT guarantee entry for 2011 due to the high volume of applications.

All unsold work entered into the Craft Fair must be picked up by January 7, 2012 (unless prior arrangements are made with the Gift Shop Manager).
