## Learn How to Create Videos & Get Paid!

*Youth Media Project* is a program for community action through media involving 7 participants between the ages of 16 – 30. In this 13-week program, youth receive training in video production by making their own film that screens locally in the community. They also work with a network of community partners to create videos through work placements — highlighting community resources and presenting ideas for community change.

**Details:** Full-time, 13-week program, Monday to Friday, 9:00am - 3:30pm

To Apply You Must Be:

- Interested in art & video
- Between the ages of 16 and 30
- Not attending school full-time
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Not on EI

Participants Receive:

- Full-time (30-34 hrs/wk) minimum wage paid training and employment (13 Weeks)
- Experience in video production, basics of graphic design & editing skills
- Consultations in career development
